Expectations

- Identify and advise on data sources for analysis

 - Advise on internal data collection and dataset development
- Monitor the quality of project data and adopt a system of ongoing quality control to ensure data accuracy
- Develop research goals in collaboration with CCJR Coordinator
- Implement analysis and presentation tools in collaboration with data development team
- Analyze data using statistical techniques appropriate for the research goals established
- Prepare findings for publication in reports and presentations
- Attend monthly Huntsville City Council Meetings
 - Speak on topics as requested/needed
- Learn about UWOC as an Organization to accomplish data analyst goals

Specifics

All stipends are based on fulfilling contraction requirements, although, we figure the typical time commitment for successful completion of project requirements is about 15-20 hours per week.
